

## Activities of Employability and Money Advice Pilot Project [May 2005 to March 2007]

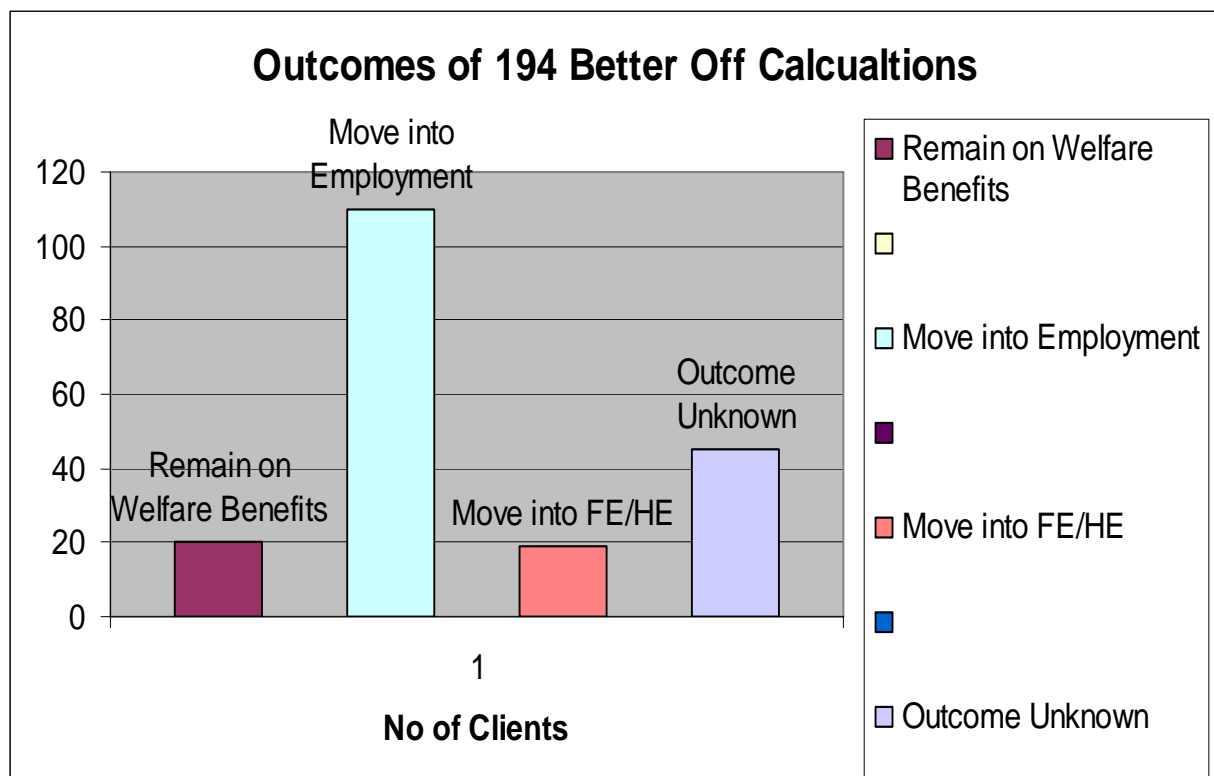
### Better Off Calculations

194 better-Off Calculations were delivered. For clients who received one:

- 110 went into employment
- 19 went into Further/Higher Education;
- 20 remained on Welfare benefits
- 45 are unknown.

The figure of 110 in Employment is broken down as:

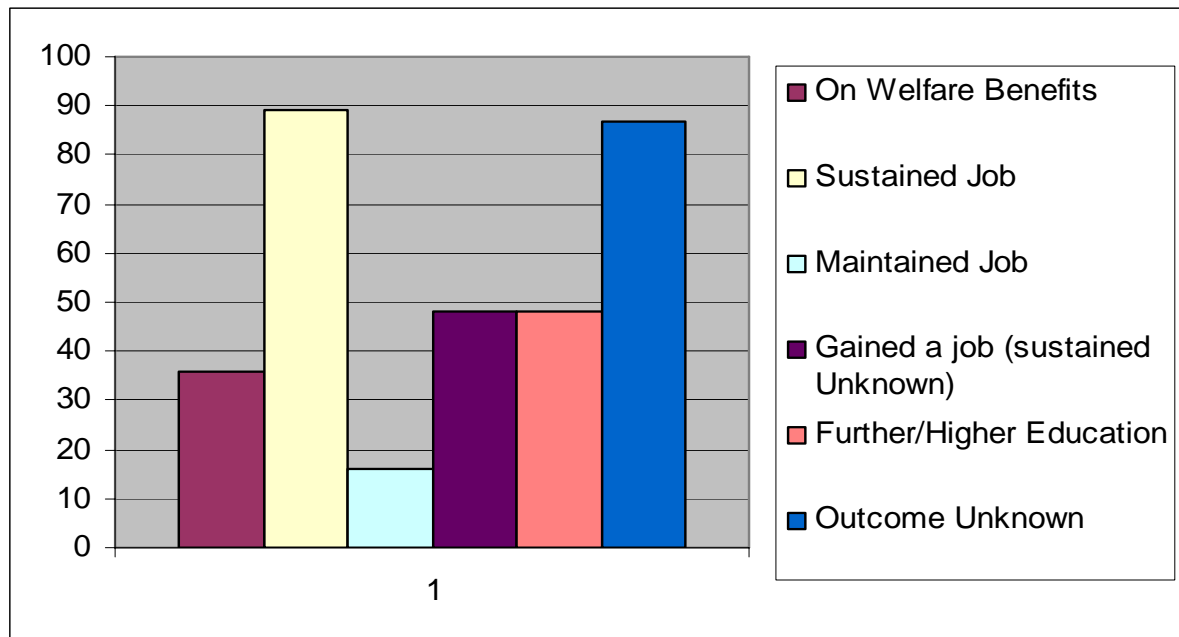
- 72 clients who entered Sustained employment (13 weeks or more);
- 29 who took up a job but either didn't sustain or who failed to respond to the Follow-Up queries
- 9 who were already employed and managed to maintain this job following the advice session.



## Client Outcomes

324 clients received a one-to-one advice session. The outcome results were as follows:

- 89 entered Sustained Employment; [27.5%]
- 36 remained on Welfare Benefits; [11.1%]
- 16 maintained their existing employment; [[4.9%]
- 48 took up employment but either failed to sustain or failed to respond to the follow up queries [14.8%]
- 48 entered Higher or Further Education [14.8%]
- 87 outcomes are unknown. [26.8%]



Of the 36 clients who remained in receipt of Welfare Benefits:

- 10 were in receipt of Incapacity Benefit
- 16 were Lone Parents on Income Support
- 6 other IS claimants
- 2 were Job Seekers Allowance claimants
- 1 Pension Credit
- 1 Carers Allowance plus DLA

Of the total client group receiving one-to-one advice, there were originally 43 Incapacity Benefit claimants. Of these:

- 19 moved into employment (44.1%)
- 8 moved onto Further/Higher Education (18.6%)
- 6 have unknown Outcomes (13.9%)
- 10 were still Benefit claimants
