Access to work training for people from Black and Minority Ethnic communities, People with disabilities, The Over 50's and those with childcare responsibilities.

A training programme designed to support people back into work by combining training with work experience to improve their confidence, self esteem and employment related skills. This course also helps participants evidence the core competencies and other essential criteria required by employers in the public sector and tourism industry. The work experience opportunity will take into account the individual's prior learning, qualifications and experience, as well as their job goals.

The training programme runs for 4 weeks and on successful completion of training, participants can gain access to work experience placements within the Public Sector and the Tourism Sector (lasting for 210 hours approx.).

The training will be taking place from 09:30am until 2:30pm and will begin on 25th May 2010.

Partnership Forum

Aims

The Joined Up For Jobs Partnership Forum was established alongside the Joined Up For Jobs Strategy in 2003 with three aims:

- Strategic - to provide a formal link for two way dialogue/influence between partner agencies and the Joined Up For Jobs Strategy Group
- Practical - to promote partnership working and develop new mechanisms to deliver Joined Up For Jobs strategy
- Co-ordination - to exchange good practice and enhance co-ordination of local services

What does it do?

The Partnership Forum holds regular meetings (see dates below). These meetings provide opportunities for networking and information sharing among local service providers, and updates on local and national policy developments and labour market trends. They give service providers a channel to feed back issues of concern from the 'frontline' to inform the evolving Joined Up For Jobs strategy and provide a focus to develop new projects and other working groups and events. The Partnership Forum also shares information via an informal e-network supported by the City of Edinburgh Council and Capital City Partnership, and the Notice Board on this website.

Who can join?

The Partnership Forum is open to all organisations providing employment support and training to adults in the Edinburgh area, and employer representatives who have an interest in building the employability of jobseekers and workers who face disadvantage. It also includes any researchers, policy makers or funders who wish to be more actively involved in and better informed on employment support provision in the area.
